Donations were discussed and the following was presented: Newman Center of Pittsburg, \$500.00; Holy Family Camp \$500.00; Ministerial Alliance/Food Pantry \$500.00; Meal In His Name \$300.00; St. Michael's Angels \$1,200.00 to be given at a later date. On a motion by Sharon Harris, seconded by Deanne VanLeeuwen, unanimous the donations were approved.

Discussion: Possibility of having the first Sunday of each month as a "Cereal Sunday" for the Food Pantry. Other churches have started doing this.
