#### **EUCHARISTIC ADORATION:**

The promise of the Holy Spirit came to the Apostles at the Ascension. The day of the Ascension was probably not as joyous as one might imagine. It was, perhaps, more emotional than happy. After all, Jesus had gathered them to say 'goodbye' as he was leaving to join His Father in heaven. He reassured them he 'wasn't leaving them as orphans' and promised that the Third Person of the Holy Trinity, the Holy Spirit, would come to help and guide the Church. "When He comes, He will lead you to all truth. You will receive power to be my witnesses in Jerusalem...even to the ends of the earth", Jesus told them. A few days later, the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles at what is known as the First Pentecost, the day that the Church was born. When reading Acts, you note that their lives were truly transformed by the fire placed in their hearts for proclaiming the Gospel. As descendants of the Apostles, we are called to be Jesus' 'witnesses' by the same Spirit, to become more like the Father, and to spread the Good News to others in our family, friends, co-workers, even strangers. Those wise enough to pray to the Holy Spirit receive special strengthening graces just as the Apostles did at that First Pentecost! Fr. Floyd said it well in an earlier column: "The Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles to help them in their 'self confidence', giving them the courage to go out and proclaim what they had been given. My mission work in Venezuela happened because I volunteered, given the strength and courage to learn the language and proclaim the Good News as given by the Holy Spirit." Remember, when we were confirmed that was our own personal Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit came directly to us through the words of the Bishop. The courage is there; we just - Marcel Normand have to tap into it.
