From the Pastor

Last week I mentioned that I was at my family reunion and the fact that we had some good eating. Today we celebrate more than good eating. We all know that in Holy Communion, we touch and taste our Lord and our God. One way that communion is explained is how we receive Christ, Body and Blood, and how we are changed because we have Christ within us. I see it as part of the mystery of the Eucharist. We cannot fully understand how the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ, but we can believe that we have received the miracle of His presence that is not bread and wine but truly the Body and Blood of Christ. Even as a child I knew that I was walking forward to receive something that only God can give us. As I grew older my perception of what was happening at church and the reality of how God can work thru the ordinary in life did change. That does not mean I was less confused by the mystery; I was more connected to the reality of what I could see as I felt closer to God. Knowing that Jesus came to be 'one like us' helps us to see a different side of the Divine Presence. Through this mystery we become one body with Christ in the embrace of our common human nature. We do not become divine, but in the receiving of Eucharist we have accepted the idea that Jesus is truly with us. We can read in scripture the words of Christ: "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him, and will make our abode with him". As we receive Christ in the Eucharist, then we are called to go out to others that they may 'see' that we are different. As he changes us, so too we can change those around us. Our expression of responsive love and gratitude after each Holy Communion should be to glorify our Savior as we deal with others and show the effect of our union with Him.

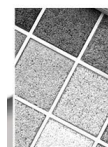
