LIFE IS SHORT, DEATH IS CERTAIN from Marcel Normand

Our weekend readings dwell on prayer and its effects. Jesus sent the seventy-two ahead to visit villages, cure the sick, and pray for the people. Noted historian C.S. Lewis, said: "If you read history, you find that the Christians who did the most for the present world were those who **THOUGHT MOST OF THE NEXT**. The Apostles who set forth to convert, the great thinkers of the Middle Ages, the English evangelicals who abolished the slave trade---all left their mark on earth precisely because their minds were **OCCUPIED WITH HEAVEN**. Since Christians have largely ceased to think of God's world, they've become less effective. **AIM AT HEAVEN** and you will get Earth thrown in; aim at Earth and you will get neither."

Pope Francis has said, "Where love of God is intense, there will be many vocations." Looking back, the Polish people have had terrible difficulties to confront. During World War II, hundreds of Polish priests were put to death by the Nazis and Communists. Yet, their courage and confidence in spite of these setbacks kept their prayer life strong and Poland today has ample priests. A real problem in America could be that we don't pray enough. Do you recall when you last prayed the rosary alone? Or did a holy hour before the Lord? Today, people need noise—in their homes, their cars, and their workplace, some type of media is blaring! Many times, they aren't even listening, but they tolerate the noise. Silence seems to be unbearable for we might even be forced to think! The best way to shut God out is to have hubbub or racket. The best way to find Him is to "be still and know that He is God."
