From the Pastor,
How God created Adam and Eve is a wonder. The first reading starts with how it happened, God forming Adam from clay and giving him "the breath of life". And it continues with how God gave them the possibility for a life of happiness in the garden which we know as Eden. Then the account takes a turn as the devil, which we know as the serpent, tempts them into eating of the tree in the middle of the garden. The account is so familiar to us; we talk of the way Adam and Eve were tempted and gave up that possibility for a happy life. They knew what God had told them; if you eat of the tree in the middle of the garden, you will die. God had made them human with a free will, they could choose when there were options to explore. Then when we finish the readings for the weekend we notice that Jesus was tempted also, yet was able to turn away from the temptation. You could say that at our baptism we also were given our spiritual breath of life as we received the grace of God and the possibility to life as children of God. We too have the possibility to live a happy life if we follow the values that we received with the grace at our baptism. However, we too are tempted and we sometimes choose to follow the way of temptation and when that happens our life is not made better, we do not reach happiness. There may be a moment when we think that we have found a kind of happiness or joy but then the reality of how that moment is only fleeting reminds us that the temptation has taken us to a place that is at most temporary. May this time of Lent be for us a reminder that our sacrifices help us to be strong in temptation and because of our strength, we can find a happiness that is not temporary.

In Ash Wednesday's readings, we heard the prophet, Joel, speak: "Even now," says the Lord, return to me with your whole heart." Then form your own 'even now' and say to Him: 'Lord, I want to return to you, even now.' Perhaps going to Confession would be a good beginning to lift the burden as we go through these 40 days. LENTEN NOTES
++Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.
++FASTING... For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.
++ABSTINENCE or abstaining from... The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.
++WAY OF THE CROSS...As we have done in the past... the Way of the Cross will be at 6PM on Fridays at Girard, come early at 5:50 for Benediction. In Arma, the Way of the Cross will be at 5:50 following 5:30 Mass, come early and worship with us at Mass.
++Bible Study...There will be a bible study during Lent on Wednesdays at 5:30 in the St. Michael's Hall. The theme will be the Mercy of God.
++After consulting the US Naval Observatory for the median time of sunset in our diocese, the additional time to be considered "nightfall", and taking into account other pastoral considerations: on April 12, 2019, because it better reveals the reality of the Light who is Christ coming into our darkness, the Easter Vigil is to begin at or after 8:30 p.m. ... So our Easter Vigil will be at 8:30PM this year THERE WILL NOT BE A MASS AT 4PM IN ARMA ON APRIL 12.
