REASONS FOR THE TRANSFIGURATION

I recall visiting with Fr. John Reinkemeyer about the Transfiguration of Jesus and asking for his thoughts. He said that this had been a subject of the Church Fathers and other noted theologians for centuries. Perhaps Raphael's greatest painting of the Renaissance Period, "The Transfiguration", 1518, tells the story of this event best. Raphael loved the painting so much that he never sold it, instead hung it over his bed, and at his death, he was said to have turned to look at it. Fr. Reinkemeyer, from his own research, reasoned that Christ wanted to bolster the faith of the Apostles prior to His crucifixion and death. In this way, they would recognize that, just as His divine glory is hidden beneath His human appearance, so, too, a real victory would be concealed in the apparent 'defeat of the Cross'. In addition, he supposed that the occurrence would cause them to know that Christ is truly divine, with Moses and Elijah bearing witness to Him, and the voice of God speaking from the cloud. Additionally, I am surmising that this might cause Christians to learn to hope for their own glory as they are transformed by God's grace. It was this image of the glorified Jesus that Raphael reflected on and labored over for years. He needed to see this transfiguration during his life and at the hour of his death to keep the faith. And so do we.

LENTEN NOTES

++Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.
++FASTING... For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.
++ABSTINENCE or abstaining from... The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.
++WAY OF THE CROSS...As we have done in the past... the Way of the Cross will be at 6PM on Fridays at Girard, come early at 5:50 for Benediction. In Arma, the Way of the Cross will be at 5:50 following 5:30 Mass, come early and worship with us at Mass.
++Bible Study...There will be a bible study during Lent on Wednesdays at 5:30 in the St. Michael's Hall. The theme will be the Mercy of God.
++After consulting the US Naval Observatory for the median time of sunset in our diocese, the additional time to be considered "nightfall", and taking into account other pastoral considerations: on April 12, 2019, because it better reveals the reality of the Light who is Christ coming into our darkness, the Easter Vigil is to begin at or after 8:30 p.m. ... So our Easter Vigil will be at 8:30PM this year THERE WILL NOT BE A MASS AT 4PM IN ARMA ON APRIL 12.
