CORPUS CHRISTI: HIS PRESENCE AND HIS PROMISE

Jesus Christ is truly present in the Holy Eucharist: Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity under each particle of the Eucharist and each drop of the Precious Blood. Fr. John Reinkemeyer explains it thusly: "At the moment of the consecration (Jesus' words instituting the Eucharist), the entire realities of bread and wine are changed into Christ's Body and Blood. Only the appearances' of bread and wine remain. The reality is the glorified Christ! The Church calls it transubstantiation." The late Fr. William Carr reminded us in his writings of what Jesus said, 'we must eat His flesh and drink His blood in order to have His life in us". It is not the mere 'eating and drinking' which brings us life, for the 'flesh profits nothing'. To truly benefit from Holy Communion, we must give ourselves to Him. To accomplish this, we must be free of serious sin and all attachment to it. We must want to serve the Lord in every way possible. These pre-requisites aren't easy to attain but we owe it to Him who redeems us.

Today's feast of Corpus Christi celebrates not an event, but a fact! Christ is always offering Himself to God, the Father. He allows us to participate in this offering by instituting the wonderful sacrament---or Sacrifice of the Altar. The Holy Eucharist is not only Christ's presence, but also 'His promise'—the promise of eternal inheritance. As the Twelve Apostles taught in the 2nd Century: "And on the Lord's Day, after you have come together, break bread and offer the Eucharist, having first confessed your offenses, so that your SACRIFICE may be pure." Let's try to have this frame of mind when we present ourselves before the Lord in Holy Communion. A devout genuflection or a reverent bow prior to reception is a good start.


