THIS IS HEAVEN

A question I regularly pose to children when teaching catechesis: "How do you imagine heaven?" Actually, I like asking young people and adults the same question. How can we speak about something we have never seen? How can we describe that which escapes our understanding because it is beyond even our most sophisticated categories? Yet everyone seems to have something to say about heaven.

Heaven is like a fiesta, a banquet, or a playground. Heaven is like a day at the beach, a trip to the mountains, or a retreat by a lake. Heaven is like gathering with friends or being with those we love most. Heaven is being in the presence of God. Nothing else matters.

The Book of Revelation describes the celestial Jerusalem as being radiant like a precious stone, high walls, twelve gates guarded by angels, with solid foundations. What a wonderful imagery. But the overall theme of this Sunday's readings seems to suggest that, more than a place or a pleasant image, heaven is peace. Not the peace we build with our human efforts, but peace as the transforming presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives.

When the Spirit is present, division is no more; then we experience God's peace. When the Spirit enlightens our minds and hearts, we know who God is and what God wants for us; then we experience peace divine.

One day a young person answered my question saying, "For me heaven is to know that God wants me to be better every day." That's it, heaven on earth; peace in the Spirit.

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTIONS

Controlled Burn

Acts 15:1-2, 22-29 / Ps 67:2-3, 5, 6, 8 / Rev 21:10-14, 22-23 / Jn 14:23-29

Happy Easter! Occasionally, our faith will be challenged and our peace disturbed by something we witness or hear. Have you ever experienced a "controlled burn"? Here in Kansas, it is a common occurrence. It could be a pile of wood, an acre, or hundreds of acres. It is a sight to see, and the heat it produces can be overwhelming. It is just so powerful! Then, it happens. A flame or ember gets away. The next thing you know it isn't a controlled burn. Peace quickly escapes with the rogue fire. In today's first reading, the early Church was confronted with a one of those rogue fires—"unless you are circumcised according to the Mosaic practice, you cannot be saved." What resulted was the Council of Jerusalem. Sometimes, it is necessary to fight fire with fire. The fire of the Holy Spirit can move quickly, too, and did back then, as it does in our time. Discussion ensued and blossomed into Church teaching. When the peace of Christ escapes you, remember what our Lord said, "do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid." God is always in control, even when the fire gets away.
