In this season, God reminds us that each moment holds the possibility of encountering the sacred. It is those seemingly ordinary moments that make up our days; an, as Annie Dillard writes, "How we spend our days is, after all, how we spend our lives."

Now it is nighttime, I have completed most of my nightly rituals, including the reading that helps me settle into the slumbering hours . . . Getting up to turn off the light, I gaze about my room. My eyes take in the stacks of books and papers that the floor around my bed draws like a magnet. There's a collection of poems by Rumi, a book of essays by Audre Lorde, a stack of magazines that arrived from Sandra in today's mail . . . A pair of jeans lies across the back of my drafting chair, tossed there earlier tonight after I returned from an evening of acoustic music at the nearby bookstore. A new oil lamp sits on the cedar table, a gift from a friend's recent trip to New Orleans. My cat, Zeke, lies beneath the table, his paws tucked under himself, settled in for the night or at least until he jumps onto my futon during the dark hours.

Turning off the light, I think of how it is the ordinary that roots me. And it is there that God challenges us to unmask her, begs us to unveil him. Night into day into night, in the crevices of the familiar, in the rhythms of our rituals and habits and encounters, God beckons us like Wisdom calling her followers daily to her gates.

Yes No Go

1 Kgs 19:16b, 19-21 / Ps 16:1-2, 5, 7-8, 9-10, 11 / Gal 5:1, 13-18 / Lk 9:51-62

Are you a "yes" man, or woman? Always saying yes to every request for help, whether dire or not? It might feel easier to say yes for one reason or another, but, after yes to this, and yes to that, before long, the other end of that yes, might be feeling like a burden. In the Diocese of Wichita, there are a plethora of opportunities to live out our mission of discipleship. However, after too many yeses, we may begin to feel like we are putting on the "yoke of slavery" as St. Paul writes to the Galatians in today's second reading. There can be a lot of pressure to say yes, especially if the person asking is higher up in the food chain. St. Paul also writes, "Beware that you are not consumed by one another." Yes, we can consume one another though our intentions are good. In today's first reading, Elisha says yes to Elijah, but he doesn't add to his burdens, in fact, he slaughters his old yoke, before beginning his new. The next time someone asks us to start, or join, something new for the Kingdom, prayfully assess the present, and decidedly commit to the future.
