PRAYERS OF INTERCESSION

One of the most difficult things for non-Catholics to understand about Catholics is our reliance on intercessory prayer. Specifically, our reliance on the prayers of other people, both living and dead.

When we ask for the prayers of others, we are not saying they are God. Nor are we saying that they are the ones who answer our prayers. We are simply asking them to pray for us—to God. The saints, especially, would be the last ones to say they are replacing God, and also the last ones to say they won't pray for us. As St. Therese of Lisieux said, "I will spend my time in heaven doing good on earth."

So how does one "do" intercessory prayer? There are many formal prayers you can use (for example, the "Memorare," which asks Mary for her help), but often all one needs to do is imagine a saint or loved one before you and ask for help. But remember this too: you also "do" intercessory prayer or when you gather with others, especially at Mass.

I'm not sure how it all "works" in heaven. But many times in my life, after I asked a particular saint for help, I received what I needed from God. And I know that if I'm lucky enough to make it into heaven, one of the first things I'll do is make a beeline to some favorite saints and say thanks. And I also expect I will meet and thank many others who prayed for me without my ever knowing it. –Fr. James Martin
