#### ORIGINS OF THE BIBLE

There are people who say they found the Catholic Church in the Bible; others state that the Catholic Church is not true BE-CAUSE OF THE BIBLE! However, the Catholic Church doesn't care one way or the other because the Church was here BE-FORE THE BIBLE! The Church would be here today if the Bible had never been written. The Catholic Church had been formed 45 years before Matthew had ever written the first Gospel of the New Testament! The Church was here 400 years before St. Jerome began to put the Bible into book form after the Council of Carthage in 397 A.D. The Church was already spreading around the world; the Holy Father was running the infant Church in those early centuries, appointing bishops where needed, and receiving dignitaries from various nations. The Church is not dependent on the Bible for its origins. The Bible BELONGS to the Church; in fact, the Church is its chief interpreter! When Catholics don't understand a Biblical passage, we turn to the Church ----we seek advice from a priest or a bishop who helps us with its meaning.

This is NOT what has happened to Protestantism--it is the reason why they have so many denominations. If a group disagrees over a Biblical passage(s), they often will organize and proclaim a new denomination that will affirm their beliefs. To date, there are over 300 such religious bodies in the world. The Bible is helpful to learning, to guidance, and to understanding when viewed and explained within the context of the Church, its guardian. Who could ever have foreseen that the Bible would be appropriated from the Church and re-interpreted many times throughout the centuries? Most of us know that many professions such as law, medicine, and the ministry require a period of training and learning prior to leading new recruits toward becoming qualified. But when it comes to interpreting the word of God, so-called experts spring from the woodwork to expound on what God really means! We know there are quacks in the medical world as well as shysters in the legal world therefore, we shouldn't be surprised to find both in the religious world! But, it does get tiresome to hear someone say, "The Bible says...." which usually means "the Bible says and it means what I want it to mean!" God didn't intend for His Word to be manipulated that way.

And so the question often brought up by skeptics or atheists when arguing the merits of the Bible is: "Just how authentic is the Bible?" We all know people who voice doubts as to whether the Bible is a true account or whether we can believe all that it describes. NO ONE can give an absolute, positive, answer on all that is in the Bible. Even the Church has had difficulty with some passages. It's no wonder that whenever individuals attempt interpretation, they usually fall into uncertainty. This is the main reason why Catholics leave this calling to the Church.

Therefore, how do we know that the Bible is true? How do we know that George Washington was our nation's first president? The answer is, "We really don't." We walk by FAITH in nearly everything. We "take the word of others." We believe that our mother is really our mother, yet we weren't really aware of it at our birth. We believe she was married to our dad, yet we weren't present at the ceremony. What I'm attempting to point out is that much of what we believe today is based on the TRUTHFULNESS of others, like parents, teachers, priests, and Christ, Himself. The written document, such as the marriage certificate, the history book, or the Bible, serves as the visible fact which can be passed on from generation to generation.

Leave skepticism behind and continue to grow in the knowledge of Jesus. Get your Bible out for it is a textbook for life. It has a positive effect in teaching us and reproaching (to fault or censure) us. This is where we come to know God. You can't love what you don't know. Make a commitment to read a few pages or paragraphs daily. Then respond in prayer to what you read. God has spoken to you. --Marcel Normand
