

One notable jump on both is the Chancery Savings which reflects changes in the investment market but gets listed under both income and expense since it's not in our general fund.

THE MYSTICAL BODY & IDENTIFYING MARKS OF THE CHURCH

As stated last week, the Church is called the 'Mystical Body of Christ'. This is done to distinguish it from the 'physical' body of Christ---His human body, which is present in Heaven & also in the Eucharist under the appearances of bread and wine. The 'Mystical Body', then, is not a physical body, like our own, nor is it merely 'organizational', such as a club, union, or corporation. It is a 'unique body', having all the elements of any organizational body PLUS A LIVING SOUL! This 'living soul' is the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity, the Holy Spirit, which unites all the members to one another and to Christ, the Head. It is called 'Mystical' because it seems mysterious--something beyond the powers of our intellect fully to understand. The Church is a sublime (noble, inspiring) mystery--visible in her external organization, but capable of being known only by 'faith' in her inner life. This Holy Spirit, therefore, is ENTIRE in Christ and EN-TIRE in the Body of Christ, in each of the members.

This Mystical Body of Christ is 'visible' in its 'human nature' by the order of rank in the Church: the visible head of the Mystical Body is the Pope, the 'vicar' (representative) of Christ. Our Lord teaches and governs through the Pope and his Bishops. Christ makes His members holy through the sacraments. Christ worships the Father (God) through the sacrifice of the Mass, which is continually offered by the WHOLE Mystical Body. Christ still suffers, but no longer in His 'physical' body, but in His 'Mystical Body'---comprised of the poor, the hungry, the afflicted throughout the world.

In order to make it possible for people of all ages to recognize His Church, Christ has given it FOUR IDENTIFYING MARKS. These Marks are: 1)THE CHURCH IS ONE. It possesses a oneness which is present amid a remarkable diversity of races, languages, cultures, & political opinions. All of the members of the Mystical Body believe the same doctrines, accept the same sacraments, worship at the Mass, and submit to the same divine authority---Christ, the Head, who rules the Mystical Body through the 'visible' Head, the Holy Father, the Pope, and his Bishops who are in communion with him. Simply stated,

Catholics believe there is only one true Church of Christ because the Church IS CHRIST! Christ cannot be divided, according to Scripture.

- a. ...one Body and one Spirit, even as you were called in one hope; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God & Father of all, who is above all, and throughout all, and in us all. Ephesians 4: 4-6
- b.and other sheep I have that are not of this fold. Them, also, I must bring, and they shall hear my voice, and there shall be one fold and one shepherd. John 10:16 We'll continue with the other 3 identifying marks of the Church.
