2 Sm 5:1-3 / Ps 122:1-2, 3-4, 4-5 / Col 1:12-20 / Lk 23:35-43
“Are you not the Christ? Save yourself and us!” Those were the words of the criminal opposite the side of the criminal that said “Jesus, remember me when you enter your kingdom.” Two pleas to be saved, one from temporary punishment on a cross and one from the eternal punishment of hell. 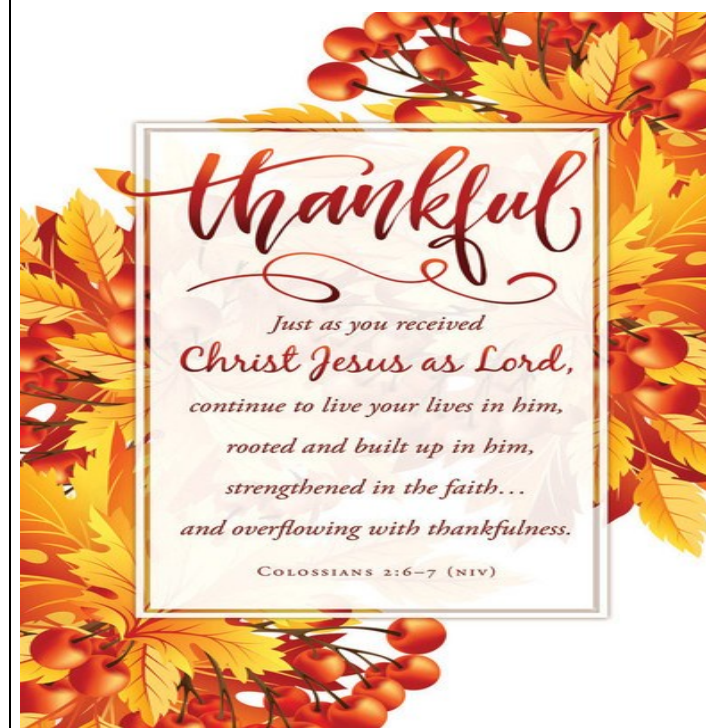
