STEWARDSHIP REFLECTIONS

The Ten Reminders

Sir 15:15-20 / Ps 119:1-2, 4-5, 17-18, 33-34 / 1 Cor 2:6-10 / Mt 5:17-37

Jesus shares four reminders in today's Gospel: "You have heard that it was said..." The writer of Sirach also reminds us, "If you choose you can keep the commandments, they will save you." All these reminders! Why do we forget so easily? Do we forget? Even the Psalmist pleads to God to have his eyes opened and to receive instruction on keeping His Commandments. Being a good steward starts with loving God. How can we authentically exhibit our love for our Creator—here is a reminder: obedience! We are asked to go further than to just obey, we are called to obey *and teach*. *Warning: as a result of being an authentic Catholic steward, it is necessary to do hard things, and remind others to do the same.*
